The school will aim to:

- Provide opportunities for each pupil to realise their potential.

- Read and acknowledge school letters, communications, reports and contact books.
- Inform the school by phone, e-mail or letter of any absence (including medical appointments) before 8.30am on the day of any absence.

- Do all they can to ensure they arrive on time with everything they need
- Be polite and friendly to all adults and to each other.
- Take growing responsibility for their learning, by doing their best at school and completing work set to complete at home (Upper KS2)
